STEPS TO GETTING PHOTO PRINTS ORGANIZED

1. Gather needed equipment
 - work table
 - note cards or sticky notepad
 - pen
 - photo storage box

2. Gather photos and bring them to one area (preferably a large working table).
3. Label years on pieces of paper, and lay them out in order on table.
4. Set timer for 30 minutes.
5. Stack photographs by year. If photos are numerous, use a bin or photo box per year. In the boxes, put dividers for season to help sort more chronologically.
6. When timer rings, look at the progress you have made. If time allows, reset the timer for another 30 minutes and keep going.
7. If photos are grouped in packs, you can then go back and sort somewhat chronologically within the year. If they are loose and all mixed up, pat yourself on the back that you got them sorted by year, and leave it at that.
